### **Important Reminder 2022**

Please read thoroughly the notes section as things may have changed due to Covid-19. We want to ensure that everyone is having fun while being safe, as safety is our number ONE priority. If you have any questions or concerns, don't be afraid to reach out.

- Masks are required by all participants, regardless of vaccination status.
- We will continue to abide by social distancing protocols to ensure everyone's safety, regardless of vaccination status.

- All members are to arrive within 30 minutes of the start time of the activity with a completed attestation form ready (please let staff know if you need new copies)
